
Operating Tips For Manual HVAC

To warm-up foot area quickly, you first need to consider if the windshield is fogged.

Some customers set the MODE SELECTOR DIAL to • . This position will provide best heater performance to foot area; however, defroster performance may be limited.



The chart below shows the airflow ratio to Floor/Defroster at each mode including intermediate positions.



Note: Once the cabin interior warms up to the desired temperature, change from Recirc () to Outside Air mode () to minimize windshield fogging.

The flow chart below shows the best heater mode positions to heat the floor, including the usage of intermediate position between Floor and Defroster/Floor.
