When a failure is detected, the EPS control unit goes into back-up mode. The new software provides partial assist during back-up mode.

## **BEFORE GETTING STARTED**

NOTE:

- If unfamiliar with the Mongoose Pro Honda Interface tool or the Electronic Power Steering Rewrite Application, refer to the following Special Tools guides:
  - Mongoose Pro Honda User Guide (ST 01937)
  - Accord EPS Rewrite Reference Guide (ST 01936)
- Connect a fully charged jumper battery to the vehicle and leave it connected during the entire procedure to maintain steady voltage.
- Never turn the ignition to OFF or ACCESSORY. If there is a problem with the update, leave the ignition turned to ON.
- To prevent EPS control unit damage, do not operate anything electrical (headlights, audio system, brakes, A/C, power windows, door locks, etc.) during the update.

## DIAGNOSIS

Connect the i-HDS and check for DTCs in the EPS system.

- If DTC 53-01 torque sensor (low/high check) or DTC 53-02 torque sensor (average check) is stored, complete this bulletin and refer to SB 15-056, *Warranty Extension: EPS Torque Sensor (DTC 53-01 or DTC 53-02)* to replace the steering gear box.
- If DTC 53-01 or DTC 53-02 is not stored, go to REPAIR PROCEDURE.

#### **REPAIR PROCEDURE**

Updating the EPS with the Mongoose Pro Honda Interface Tool.

NOTE:

- Make sure you have the latest software loaded to your PC.
- During the software update, DO NOT turn off the ignition to OFF. Doing so during the update will damage the control unit.
- 1. Connect a jumper battery to the vehicle and leave it connected during the entire procedure to maintain a steady voltage.
- 2. Connect the Mongoose Pro Honda cable between the PC and the vehicle's DLC.
- 3. Select the EPS Rewrite Icon on your PC.



4. Click on the **I Agree** button.

3.	At the vehicle, turn the ignition switch ON(II), then connect the pass-thru device to the vehicle's SAE J1962 connector (DLC).
