# 2017 QX30; PUSH-BUTTON IGNITION SWITCH MID-YEAR CHANGE

APPLIED VEHICLES: 2017 QX30 (H15)

#### SERVICE INFORMATION

A mid-year change has been made to the ignition system in the Applied Vehicles.

Vehicles produced November 3, 2016 and after (see VIN information on page 2) are equipped with a pushbutton ignition switch instead of a turning ignition swich.

#### WARNING:

- Do NOT retrofit the push-button ignition switch to vehicles produced before the application date. Please reference Infiniti Parts and Service Bulletin IPSB/16-422.
- Modifications to the ignition switch are unauthorized, and may violate Federal law by making inoperative a device installed in compliance with Federal safety standards.
- Damage or failure due to changes or modifications to the ignition switch system are not covered under the terms of the warranty.
- Damage or failure due to changes or modifications to the ignition switch system are not subject to indemnification under the terms of the Infiniti Dealer Sales and Service Agreement.
- Retailers may be obligated under their Sales and Service Agreement to indemnify Infiniti for any damages, injuries, or deaths caused by modification of the ignition switch system.


