Information: This is to inform you of a voluntary Workshop Campaign on the above-mentioned vehicles. **There is a**

possibility that the adhesive material on the affected vehicles was not fitted in accordance with

the instructions due to a manufacturing problem.

As a result, noises can occur in the roof-assembly area over the service life of the vehicle.

Action Required:

Check the roof-assembly bonding and rework it if necessary.

Affected Vehicles:

The VIN(s) can be checked by using PIWIS Vehicle Information link to verify if the campaign affects the vehicle. This campaign is scope specific to the VIN! Failure to verify in PIWIS may result in an improper

repair. This campaign affects 19 vehicles in North America.

Work Procedure: 1 Remove headliner ⇒ Workshop Manual '708419 Removing and installing headliner - section on "Removing"'

2 Check that the adhesive bead *⇒ Roof-assembly bonding (without slide/tilt roof)* **-arrows-** is visible along the entire length between roof assembly and bodyshell flange.



Roof-assembly bonding (without slide/tilt roof)

- If there is no adhesive bead along the entire length between roof and bodyshell, the roof has to be re-affixed using 2-component adhesive. ⇒ Continue with Step 3
- If there is an adhesive bead along the entire length, re-install the headliner. ⇒ Continue with Step 5.
- 3 Unscrew fastening nuts ⇒ Fastening nuts on roof assembly-1- on the roof assembly at front and rear.
- 4 Install roof assembly with new roof joint cover strip as described in the Workshop Manual.


2 Check that the inner adhesive bead *⇒ Roof-assembly bonding (slide/tilt roof)* **-arrow-** is visible along the entire length between roof assembly and bodyshell flange.



Roof-assembly bonding (slide/tilt roof)

- If there is no adhesive bead along the entire length between roof and bodyshell, the roof has to be re-affixed using 2-component adhesive. ⇒ Continue with Step 3
- If there is an adhesive bead along the entire length, re-install the headliner. ⇒ Continue with Step 8.
- 3 Remove sliding-roof panel ⇒ Workshop Manual '604019 Removing and installing sliding-roof panels section on "Removing".

4 Release ⇒ Disconnecting electric plug connection
 -1- and unplug electric plug connections.

- 5 Unscrew fastening nuts ⇒ Fastening nuts on roof assembly -1 on the roof assembly at front and rear.
- 6 Install roof assembly (slide/tilt roof) with new seals for roof assembly as described in the Workshop Manual.

Labor, parts, and sublet will be automatically inserted when Technician is selected in WWS/PQIS. If necessary, the required part numbers will need to be manually entered into warranty system by the dealer administrator.
