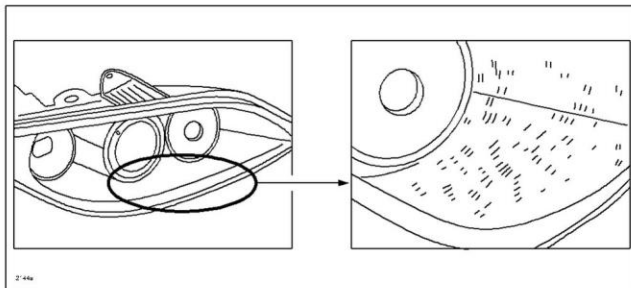

DESCRIPTION

CAUTION

Take caution when cleaning plastic headlight lenses. Damage can occur when using some cleaners that contain strong acid, alkaline cleanser or organic solvent. Damage caused by using these cleaners is not covered by Mazda's New Vehicle Limited Warranty term.

NOTE: Some brushes can be too abrasive and also cause damage to headlight lenses.

RECOMMENDED CLEANING PROCEDURE

Clean headlight lenses with luke warmwater. If necessary, use mild detergent with lukewarm water.
