AHM is interested ONLY if the vehicle meets the following requirements:

- 1. Tire leak MUST be identified around the outside of the valve stem at the rubber grommet when performing the water tank dunk test.
- 2. No previous accidents or collisions.
- 3. No previous repairs for this issue.
