

#### Introduction

Some 2011 – 2017 model year CT200h vehicles may exhibit a metallic clicking noise from the front of the vehicle when driving over a washboard-type road surface, or a creaking noise when turning left or right. A new Front Suspension Support Sub-assembly (front strut cap support) is now available to address this condition.

Is there a metallic clicking or creaking noise from the front strut cap support?

# Repair Procedure (continued)

2. Remove the front strut cap support.

- Inspect the front strut assembly.

- 4. Install the front strut assembly with the NEW front strut cap support.
