# Software update DME

## **Situation**

In the course of quality observation BMW Motorrad has found that despite sufficient oil level, the yellow warning light and the "Check Oil" can appear in the display.

### Vehicles affected

In order to determine if a specific vehicle is affected by this Technical Campaign, it will be necessary to verify all vehicle VINs through a DCS Vehicle History Check. Based on the response of the system, either proceed with the repair or take no further action. Please note, affected VINs may not appear until 24-72 hours after the release of this bulletin

#### **Production solution**

Vehicles dispatched since 17 May 2016 have optimized software uploaded to the DME control units (integration level K001-16-07-501) in series production.

#### Service solution

Before delivery or during the next workshop visit of vehicles affected, perform a software update with ISTA/P version 3.59.0 (integration level K001-16-07-501) or higher.

## **NOTICE**

The rollout of the new software in the markets will happen from 06/09/2016 to 06/30/2016.

It is essential to state the ISTA/P version used in the final report.
