# 2017 QX30; PUSH-BUTTON IGNITION SWITCH MID-YEAR CHANGE

#### SERVICE INFORMATION

A mid-year change has been made to the ignition system in the Applied Vehicles.

Vehicles produced on November 3, 2016 and after (see VIN information on page 2) are equipped with a pushbutton ignition switch instead of a turning ignition switch.

**NOTE:** See Figures 1 and 2 on page 2 to view images of both ignition switches.

In addition, vehicles equipped with the push-button ignition switch include the following features:

- All doors automatically unlock when the ignition is turned OFF
- All doors automatically lock when the vehicle speed reaches 15 MPH
- Windows open/close when holding down Intelligent Key unlock/lock button
- Emergency engine shut off by rapidly pushing ignition switch three (3) times
