PURPOSE

This TSB updates the Steering section of the affected Service Manuals to update the lubricant, sealant, special tools, and procedures used in replacement of the Tie Rod End Ball Joint Dust Cover, which are now serviceable parts, for vehicles with hydraulic power steering.



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TIE ROD END BALL JOINT DUST COVER REPLACEMENT

There are two types (Type A and B) of the tie rod end ball joint dust cover. When you replace it, observe the tie-rod end screwin portion to determine which is fitted in the vehicle.



⚠ CAUTION

If the tie rod end ball joint dust cover is damaged accidentally during service work, replace the tie rod end ball joint dust cover as follows:

1. Fill and apply the specified grease into the inside and lip of the tie rod end ball joint dust cover.

Specified grease: Multipurpose grease SAE J310, NLGI No.2 or equivalent Usage (Total amount):


Inside of dust cover: 5.0 \pm 1.0 g (0.18 \pm 0.04 oz) Lip: As required.

NOTE: Wipe off the grease on the ball joint so that the amount of grease inside the tie rod end ball joint dust cover does not exceed the total amount.


- 2. Use the following special tools to press-fit the tie rod end ball joint dust cover into the tie rod end.
- Cap installer (MD998812)
- Installer 100 (MD998813)
- Installer adapter (MD998818)
- Installer adapter (MD998820)

NOTE.

- There should be no grease on the thread of the ball joint.
- There should be no clearance between the tie rod end ball joint dust cover and the tie rod end.
- Check the tie rod end ball joint dust cover for cracks or damage by pushing it with your finger.



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<Type B>

Required Special Tools:

MB990776: Front axle base

⚠ CAUTION

If the tie rod end ball joint dust cover is damaged accidentally during service work, replace the tie rod end ball joint dust cover as follows:

1. Fill and apply the specified grease into the inside and lip of the tie rod end ball joint dust cover.

Specified grease: Multipurpose grease SAE J310,

NLGI No.2 or equivalent Usage (Total amount):

Inside of dust cover: 5.0 \pm 1.0 g (0.18 \pm 0.04 oz)

Lip: As required.

NOTE: Wipe off the grease on the ball joint so that the amount of grease inside the tie rod end ball joint dust cover does not exceed the total amount.

2. Apply the specified sealant to the tie rod end ball joint dust cover mounting surface at the tie rod end.

Semi-drying sealant: ThreeBond 1215 or equivalent Application amount: As required.

3. Drive in the tie rod end ball joint dust cover with special tool front axle base (MB990776) until it is fully seated.

NOTE:

- There should be no grease on the thread of the ball joint.
- There should be no clearance between the tie rod end ball joint dust cover and the tie rod end.
- 4. Check the tie rod end ball joint dust cover for cracks or damage by pushing it with your finger.
