#### Warranty Battery Testing Descriptions for the VAS 6161

Inventory Test: Use this test mode only for vehicles in dealer inventory before the customer warranty start date.

<u>Warranty Test:</u> Use this test mode only for vehicles under the current customer vehicle warranty. VIN number input and battery information is a mandatory input for proper claim submittal. Always provide the battery test code for all battery warranty claims.

<u>Service Test:</u> This test **IS NOT** to be used for any warranty battery testing. It is designed for out of warranty battery testing only and for customer pay maintenance.

**Note:** For PDI vehicles, use only the INC- 940 for testing as per the PDI check list and the 'Ready Set Go' documents on ServiceNet.
