
## **Resolution:**

- 1. Check the caliper slide pins and caliper for free movement.
- 2. Check to ensure that the caliper slide pins are within specifications
- 3. Check caliper pistons for binding
- 4. Replace any worn pins or calipers
- During reassembly clean the pins with non-abrasive solvents and re-lubricate with Shell Albida PPS-1 grease 2585384C1 (3 oz. tube).

## Recommended brake pads:

On vehicles under 26,000# GVWR install the light duty lining HX-402. Use axle set part number 2508013C91 for 66 MM calipers, and axle set part number 2508014C91 for the 73 MM calipers.

For vehicles over 26,000# GVWR install the International aftermarket lining 7610. Use axle set part number ZJCMKD 786A for 66 MM calipers, and axle set part number ZJCMKD 786 for 73 MM calipers.



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
