**Symptom/Vehicle Issue**: LED Front Fog Lamps Flicker Or Intermittently Light, Are Dim Or Inoperative. A U11E9, or B16FB-15 may be set

**Diagnosis:** The customer may complain the front LED fog lamps flicker, intermittently light, are dim or inoperative. Upon scanning the vehicles for DTC you may find U11E9 or B16FB-15. Inspect the fog lamp connectors verifying the connectors are fully seated and engaged. To verify, disengage and re-engage the female side of the fog lamp connector.

It is also advised to inspect the fascia connector for water intrusion and corrosion. Clean, replace and repair as necessary.

**Repair Procedure:** If the fog lamps still do not light and/or flicker. Verify power and ground going to the fog lamp connector. If no issues are found, replace the fog lamp.
