Purpose

This document is for a Thomas Payne seating control box, which is for theater chairs with open/close options. This explains how to update the box from version 1 to version 2.

Resources Required

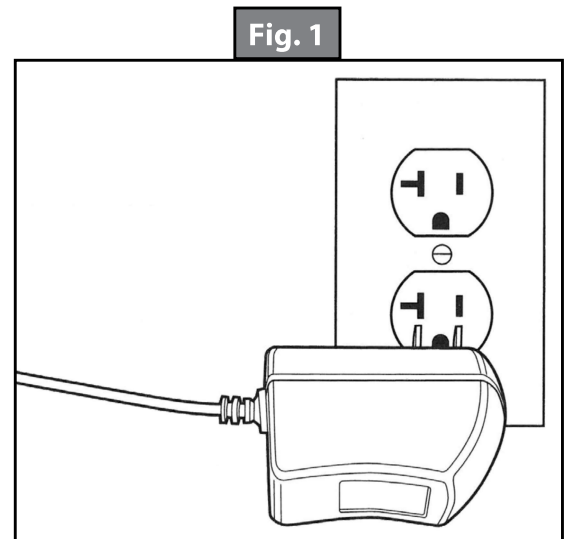
- Cordless or electric drill or screw gun
- Appropriate drive bits
- Utility knife
- Staple gun

Procedure

1. Unplug power connection from the outlet (Fig.1).

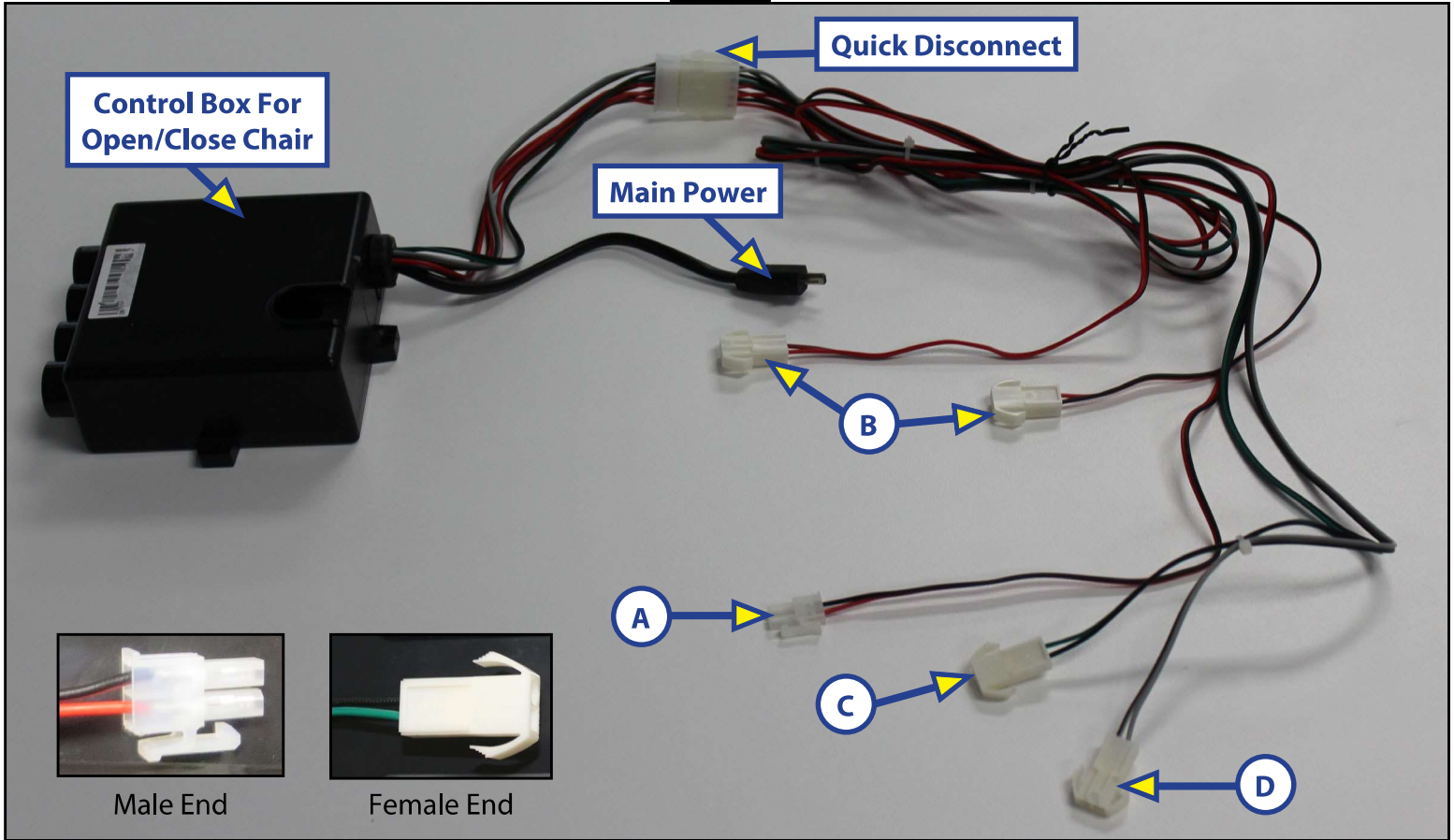
NOTE: Place a protective fabric down before turning the chair over.

2. Flip chair upside down to view the control box.
3. Use screw gun and proper bit to remove the three screws that attach the control box to the chair.
4. With utility knife carefully cut the straps that hold the wiring harness to the edge of the chair.

Callout	Description
A	Red/black wire, male end; seat heat
B	Red/black wire, female end (2); LED lights
C	Green/black wire, female end; massage
D	Gray/black wire, female end; massage

5. Unplug controller and wiring harnesses (A-D) (Fig. 2) from the other harnesses in the chair.
6. Remove and replace the control box with the new control box using the three screws.
7. Reattach all harnesses (A-D) and main power plug (Fig. 2).
8. Gather all wiring harnesses and reattach to the chair with straps and staple gun.
9. Plug control box back into power source.
