## **PURPOSE**

A dealer may find a stain or cloudy spot on the body panels after removing the transportation film. Due to improper installation of the film wrap, a bubble may be present and allow moisture such as humidity to remain on the painted surface for a long period of time. As a result, a stain or cloudy spot may appear on the clear coat.

**It is not necessary to repaint the affected area.** This TSB instructs the dealers of the repair procedure for removal of the stain.

#### DO NOT REPAINT THE VEHICLE FOR THIS CONDITION.

Dry the stain (cloudy spot) by applying heat from a ultraviolet heat lamp or blow dryer set on hot or high heat.
