STORING YOUR SLINGSHOT



Inspect tires for wear and damage, replace as needed.



Add a fuel stabilizer and fill the tank.



Conduct routine battery maintenance.



Inspect electrical system and spark plugs.



Plug air intake and exhaust to keep out pests.



Change the oil and filter.



Check fluids and verify coolant is sufficient for your storage location.
