## SERVICE INFORMATION

Infiniti is issuing this Technical Service Bulletin to clarify that a change has been made for the logic that controls the Occupant Classification System (OCS) and "passenger airbag indicator" (PABI), as described in the Owner's Manual. This TSB applies only to vehicles using the 2-sensor OCS.

Those changes are:

PABI light is ON with an empty front passenger seat.

The following table below illustrates when the PABI illuminates with the logic change.

CONDITION	DESCRIPTION	PASSENGER AIR BAG INDICATOR LIGHT	FRONT PASSENGER AIR BAG STATUS
Empty	Empty front passenger seat	ON (illuminated)	INHIBITED
Nobody/Somebody	Bag or Child or Child Restraint or Small Adult in the front passenger seat	ON (illuminated)	INHIBITED
Adult	Adult in front passenger seat	OFF (dark)	ACTIVATED
