IMPORTANT REMINDER: VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.

#### **URGENT AIRBAG SAFETY RECALL: IMMEDIATE ACTION REQUIRED!**

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) are contacting you personally because your [YEAR] [MODEL] has a recalled airbag that could <u>seriously injure or kill you and your passengers</u> if it deploys.

NHTSA and the DMV have received information from Volkswagen that the [YEAR] [MODEL] that is currently registered in your name with the Vehicle Identification Number [XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX] has been recalled. If the airbags deploy, in some cases the airbags may explode and spray sharp metal fragments or shrapnel toward you and your passengers.

Volkswagen is one of 19 vehicle manufacturers affected by this recall. NHTSA reports 18 confirmed deaths in the United States and hundreds of alleged injuries resulting from this defect.
