

## TT451: BIG TWIN HYDRAULIC CAM CHAIN TENSIONER STICKING

All 2007 and Later Models with Big Twin Powertrain	Abnormal or Excessive Noise

## **Symptom**

Noise from the cam chest area possibly accompanied by milky engine oil.

## Issue

Moisture can cause slight swelling in the tensioner causing it to stick in the housing. A vehicle that makes repeated short trips can have this condition because the engine does not reach normal operating temperatures, allowing condensation and moisture to build up in the engine oil.

## Resolution

If the oil is milky, change the oil and filter. Ride the vehicle until oil reaches 180 °F (82 °C) or higher to evaporate the residual moisture in the oil. This can require riding 20 miles (32 km) or more to reach this temperature. The tensioner should then operate normally.
