An SSM is a quick method of communicating "Need To Know" information to the technical service community. SSM's may be issued in advance of a technical bulletin or may be the only communication on a given topic. All information contained in Land Rover technical communications are intended for use by trained, professional technicians with the knowledge, tools, and equipment required to complete the procedure correctly and safely. It informs the Technicians of conditions that may occur on some vehicles, or provides information that could assist in correct vehicle and diagnostic service.

Loss of calibration within the Roof Opening Panel
motor assembly

Action:

Please complete the following steps:

- Start the engine and leave running during the initialization process
- Make sure that the roof opening panel blind/roof opening panel glass is in the fully closed position - press the close switch to achieve this
- Press and hold the close switch again and wait for the roof opening panel glass to jog forward a few millimetres and then return to its original position (this should take approximately 30 seconds), then release the switch
- Within 3 seconds, press and hold the close switch. The roof opening panel blind/roof opening panel glass will automatically travel toward the open position and then to the fully closed position. Release the switch when movement is complete
