Condition	Some customers may comment that the Stop/Start function is inoperative, and the MIL is illuminated. Some technicians may find DTC P3055 (DC/DC Converter Output Voltage 1 Performance) set in the Engine Control Module (ECM).	
Cause	This concern may be caused by the DC/DC Module being mis-configured and Channel 1 doesn't boost properly.	

	Refer to Document ID# 4773341: Circuit/System Verification/Testing. Verify a test lamp does not turn on between terminal 10 and ground:
Correction	 If the test lamp turns on, repair the short to voltage on circuit 2172. If the test lamp does not turn on, remove all appropriate fuses supplied by circuit 2172. Test for infinite resistance between Terminal 10 at the T19 Power Supply Transformer and ground:
	Note: A less than infinite reading can be caused by component circuits being shorted to another component within the harness or a slight chafe to grounds preventing a fuse to open.
	 If less than infinite, repair the short to ground on the circuit. If infinite resistance, replace the T19 Power Supply Transformer.
