## DESCRIPTION

MX-3	If "ERR" is flashing, this means that the ANTI-THEFT function of the radio has been activated, and the radio will become inoperative.	
MX-5 (Miata)	There are three different procedures depending on the type of radio that the vehicle is equipped with, make sure the correct procedure is used to enter the "Master Code". NOTE: To identify the audio unit refer to the model number located on the faceplate.	
Millenia	The audio system of the Millenia becomes inoperative after battery power is interrupted, the customer attempts to change the code or the customer enters a new code improperly. The radio display then reads "ERR".	

## **REPAIR PROCEDURE**

In order to enable the radio, follow the steps below:
