




2011MY - Current Isuzu N-Series Crew Cab Vehicles

INFORMATION

On Isuzu N-Series Crew Cab Models, most engine and engine driven components for on-vehicle service, both for gasoline and diesel engines, can be accessed through the interior of the cab. There are 3 access points to create space for service and maintenance. The 3 access points are:









Passenger Front Seat (Access the front of the engine and radiator)



Driver Front Seat (Access the front of the engine, power steering pump, vacuum pump)



Rear Seat Access (Access for intake manifold, rear of engine, front of transmission)
