



# DESCRIPTION OF STRUCTURE AND OPERATION



- The transmitter is integrated into the master key.
- When either switch is pressed, the transmitter emits a radio signal representing a specific ID code.
- There are two switches on the transmitter; the lock switch and the unlock switch.
- An indicator light, which illuminates when signals are transmitted, is added on the key grip. This indicator light informs you of the signal transmission status and warns you of flat battery.
- A brilliant silver Three-diamond mark is installation on the back side of the key grip to improve appearance.
- A signal transmission circuit (printed circuit) and a battery are housed in one case. The case is housed in the key grip, thus improving resistance to water ingress.
- A coin type battery, CR1620 is used in the transmitter.
- The transmitter switch operation allows the system to operate as follows:

There are three switches on the transmitter; the lock switch, unlock switch and the panic switch (Refer to GROUP 54A - Panic alarm system ).

Function	Transmitter operation	System operation
Standard function	Press the lock switch once.	All doors (including the liftgate) are locked.
(lock/unlock)		NOTE: . If the retracting function of the electric folding mirrors is added using a customization function, it can be retracted in synchronization with a lock operation.
	Press the unlock switch once.	All doors (including the liftgate) are unlocked.
		NOTE: . If the opening function of the electrical folding mirrors is added as an adjustment function, it can be opened in synchronization with an unlock operation.
Multi mode function	Press the lock switch once to lock all doors (including the liftgate), and within 30 seconds press the lock switch twice consecutively.	The door mirrors are retracted.
	Press the unlock switch once to unlock all doors (including the liftgate), and within 30 seconds press the unlock switch twice consecutively.	The door mirrors return to the original position.
Power door locks with selective unlocking	Press the unlock switch once to unlock the driver's door, and within 2 seconds, press the unlock switch again to unlock the front passenger's door, rear doors and liftgate.	Power door locks with selective unlocking. NOTE: . Using a customization function, the power door locks with selective unlocking can be enabled or disabled.
