#### **Customer states:**

- No navigation map or directions are displayed on the heads-up display (HUD) (Figure 1).
- All other information is displayed properly.

A software-related malfunction in the HUD can cause the navigation information not to be displayed.

### **Service**

### Applies to vehicles with high-voltage components:

To prevent charging of the high-voltage battery during the software update, the high-voltage cable is to be removed BEFORE entry of the SVM code on vehicles with high-voltage components.

Charging the high-voltage battery during a software update can damage the high-voltage components.

This TSB replaces Pending Service Solution (PSS) TSB 2065815: *PSS 90 Head-up display: Navigation directions are not displayed.* 

#### **SVM Update Instructions**



Always use DoIP when flashing a control module via ODIS in supported vehicles.

To Activate DoIP, select Administration>>General>>GFF Process>>DoIP communication>>Only allow DoIP communication

This setting will automatically reset when the diagnostic session is ended.

You can tell if DoIP is active by observing a red LED on the VAS 6154(A)

1. Follow all instructions in TSB 2011732: 00 Software Version Management (SVM), operating instructions.

2. Update the HUD (diag. addr. 0082) using the SVM action code as listed in the table below, if necessary:
