



ENTRANCE DOOR MAGNETIC HOLDER INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

 Begin by locating screws under entrance door screw cover. Mark screw locations so they won't interfere during installation (Figure 1)



- 2. Insert shim between the two catches to allow for spacing during installation. (Figure 2)
- 3. Fasten catch on door first. Then use #10 x1.5" self-taping screw to screw.
 - a. Note: Start screw with screw gun and then finish snugging by hand to prevent any stripping.






- 4. Continue by fastening catch on the frame. Use #10 x1.5" self-taping screws. (Figures 4 & 5)
 a. Note: Start screw with screw gun and finish snugging by hand to prevent stripping.
- 5. Be sure not to overtighten screws, which could make catch rock back causing loss of magnet contact between catches.





6. Figure 6 and 7 shows what the magnetic holder should look like at completion. Remove shims once completed.
