Dear Valued Customer:

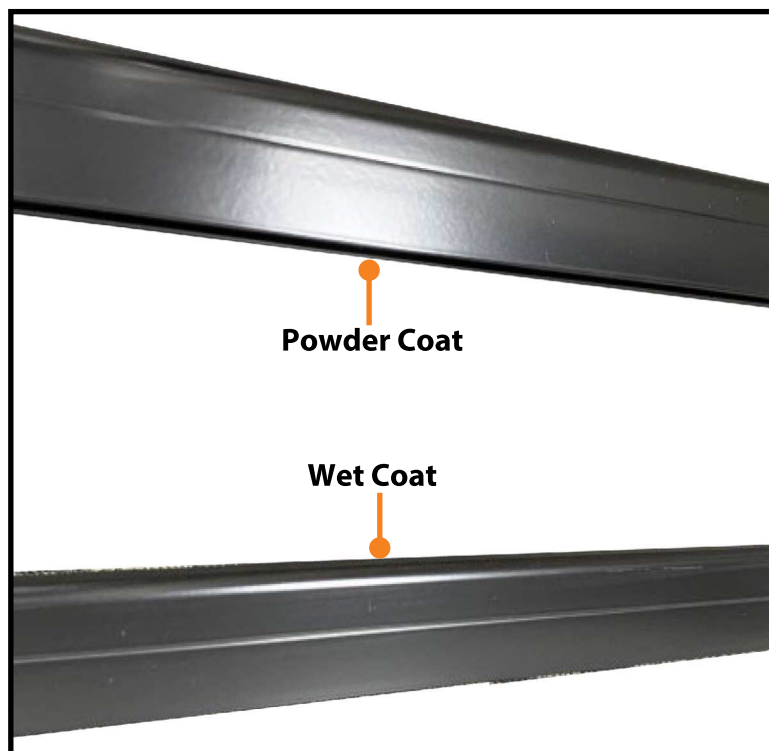
Please be advised, Plant 110 and 150 marine windshields have added wet paint as an approved supplied finish coating to aluminum frame extrusions that may have previously been supplied as powder coated.

Adding wet paint as an approved coating for our supplied aluminum extrusions will allow us to increase availability and inventory of painted extrusions by qualifying more suppliers and improving our delivery performance.

Monitoring has shown the wet paint to be as effective as powder coat.

There is no change in product installation or operation with the wet paint.

There is no price change and no part number change. The change has been made on a running basis.
