## Technical Background

These stains are caused by contact with high pH cleaners that have not been sufficiently rinsed away, salt exposure, repeated contact with silicone based washer solvents, and etc.

## Production Solution

These stains can be removed with a soft cloth or non-abrasive sponge and warm soapy water without damage to the trim and seals. Replacement of the trim and/or seals for this condition is not necessary and is not approved under warranty.
