In conjunction with the Colorado DMV, Audi will be sending Takata airbag recall reminder notices to approximately 2,174 Audi owners in the State of Colorado on February 13, 2023.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and the Colorado Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) are contacting you personally because your [YEAR] [MODEL] has a recalled airbag that could **kill or seriously injure you and your passengers** if it deploys.

NHTSA and the Colorado DMV have received information from Audi that the [YEAR] [MODEL] that is currently registered in your name with the last 8 digits of the Vehicle Identification Number being [XXXX-XXX] has been recalled. **If the airbag deploys, a part inside the airbag may explode** and spray sharp metal fragments or shrapnel toward you and your passengers.

According to records from Audi, your vehicle has not been repaired yet. The potentially lifesaving recall repair is **FREE** and parts are available now. If needed, **FREE** alternate transportation may be available to you. Please **call or text your Recall ID [XXXX-XXX] to [XXX-XXX-XXXX]** for more information or to schedule a **FREE** recall repair.

What should you do?

- **Immediately** contact a local Audi dealership to schedule a **FREE** recall repair. Ask for **FREE** alternative transportation if needed.

- *If you think you have already taken action on this recall*, visit NHTSA.gov/recalls and enter your vehicle's VIN to verify and ensure that no other safety recalls have been issued for your vehicle. If you no longer own this vehicle, please call [XXX-XXX-XXXX] to let us know so that we can remove you from further communication regarding this urgent airbag safety recall issue.



ENTER YOUR VIN

Audi is one of 19 vehicle manufacturers affected by this recall. NHTSA reports 23 confirmed deaths from other manufacturers in the United States and hundreds of alleged injuries resulting from this defect.

Please encourage your family and friends to check for vehicle safety recalls using their VIN at NHTSA.gov/recalls or safeairbags.com.

You and your family's safety on Colorado roadways is our top priority. **Please act NOW to protect yourself and your passengers.**

If you believe that Audi or your Audi dealership is unable to remedy the defect without charge within a reasonable time, you may submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue S.E., Washington, DC 20590, or you may call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hot Line at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153), or go to NHTSA.gov.

This notice is being provided and paid for by Audi, in cooperation with the Colorado Division of Motor Vehicles. Taxpayer dollars were not used. Due to the serious nature of this recall, the Colorado Division of Motor Vehicles is providing limited assistance with these notices to individuals who may be impacted by this recall. The manufacturer is fully responsible for this recall, notification of the recall, and any repairs. This notification does not create a duty upon the State of Colorado and the Colorado Division of Motor Vehicles to provide notice nor any repair requirement regarding this recall, or any other recalls or safety-related information.
