Evaporator Drain - Correct body installation location.

Technical Background

Possibility of installing the evaporator drain tube in an incorrect location in the body.

Service

There are two stamped holes in the passenger floor pan area. During replacement/reinstallation the evaporator drain tube can be installed incorrectly in the wrong unused stamped hole as seen in figure 1.

When replacing/reinstalling the evaporator drain use the stamped hole in the passenger floor pan to the right of the hole in the body tunnel as shown below.


