### Customer states:

The instrument cluster message “**Lane departure warning fault**” appears when the vehicle is started.

### Workshop findings:

The following DTCs are stored in the steering control unit J500 (address 0044):

- U13D500 Function restriction, directional stabilization assistance (Symptom code 15872).
- C135DF1 Power steering control module does not implement request (Symptom code 17920).
