• DTC C111204 (All Wheel Drive clutch pump faulty).

There is no communication with the all-wheel drive control module, J492 (address word 0022) and fuse SC44 is blown.

Technical Background

There is an internal leak in the hydraulic pump.

Production Solution

Improved hydraulic pump.

Service

- 1. Before proceeding, confirm that the issue matches the *Condition* exactly.
- 2. If Fuse SC44 is blown, replace the fuse and continue.
- Confirm that the propeller shaft from the transmission to the differential is transmitting power to the rear differential.
- 4. Replace the BorgWarner™ clutch pump according to the Elsa Repair Manual.
- Replace the high-performance oil for the Borg Warner™ clutch according to the Elsa Repair Manual.
- 6. Perform all-wheel drive basic settings



Note:

The final drive and the BorgWarner™ clutch have separate oil circuits. Refer to ETKA for information on which oil to use, and refer to the Elsa Repair Manual for draining and filling information.

- The BorgWarner™ clutch uses high-performance oil for clutches, and the final drive uses gear oil.




Figure 1. Drain plug for BorgWarner clutch oil (A), oil filler plug for BorgWarner clutch oil (B), gear oil drain plug (C), and oil filler plug for gear oil (D).

- The image on the right (Figure 1) shows the correct drain and fill plugs.
