| Cause: | A drain hose not manufactured according to specifications may have been installed on the heater/fresh-air unit on affected vehicles. |
| | If so, it cannot be ruled out that condensation may accumulate in the air conditioning drainage system during regular operation and over the service life of the vehicle. As a result, moisture can enter the vehicle interior via the footwell ventilation duct. |
| Action: | Replace the drain hose on the heating/fresh-air unit. |
| Affected Vehicles: | Only vehicles assigned to the campaign (see also PCSS Vehicle Information). |

2 Remove the cover under the dashboard on the passenger's side. \Rightarrow Workshop Manual '702219 Removing and installing cover under dashboard'


Note the installation position of the drain hose \Rightarrow *Drain hose*. The new drain hose must be installed in this position.

3 Replacing drain hose on heating/fresh-air unit



Drain hose

- 3.1 Loosen spring band clamp \Rightarrow *Pulling off drain hose* **-3** and pull the drain hose off the heating/fresh-air unit.
- 4 Disconnect and remove the drain hose from the body wall.
- 5 Coat the new drain hose with water.
- 6 If there is no spring band clamp on the new drain hose, use the clamp from the old hose.
- 7 Install the new drain hose, but do not yet fasten the spring band clamp. Check that the drain hose is seated correctly.



Pulling off drain hose


- 8 Move the vehicle onto a lifting platform and raise it. \Rightarrow Workshop Manual '4X00IN Lift vehicle'
- 9 From the underbody of the vehicle, ensure again that the drain hose is seated correctly. Lug ⇒ Drain hose seating -1- must point upwards and drain hose opening ⇒ Drain hose seating -2- must point downwards. It is also important that the drain hose is seated correctly along entire groove ⇒ Drain hose seating -Arrow- in the body wall. Tighten the drain hose from below if necessary.
- 10 Remove vehicle from the lifting platform. ⇒ Workshop Manual '4X00IN Lifting the vehicle'

- 11 Fasten spring band clamp \Rightarrow Pushing on drain hose -3- to the drain hose.
- 12 Install the cover under the dashboard. \Rightarrow Workshop Manual '702219 Removing and installing cover under dashboard'
- 13 Enter the campaign in the Warranty and Maintenance booklet.
