Service

- 1. Read out the production date of the instrument cluster via ODIS. Self diagnosis>> Address 17: instrument cluster>>Identification>>Production date
 - a. If the cluster production date is **AFTER** September 30th 2023, submit a photo of the production date and image of the cluster to DOC-IT and the replace the cluster
 - b. If the production date is **BEFORE** September 30th 2023, no documentation is needed. Replace the cluster.
- 2. Replacement clusters received **BEFORE** the September 30th 2023 production may still be used.
