<p>This is to notify you of an INITIAL Recall Campaign concerning the Top Coat Paint Adhesion on approximately 5 MY 2021 Freightliner Sprinter Vans. The recall campaign will be visible on the www.safercar.gov website and may generate questions from customers. All affected VINs will be flagged as "PENDING" in VMI and cannot be sold.</p>		
Background		
Issue	<p>Mercedes-Benz AG, the manufacturer of Sprinter vehicles, has determined that on certain Sprinter (907 platform) vehicles, the chemical composition of the topcoat paint might not meet specifications. In such case, adhesion of the fixed windows to the vehicle body might be impaired. As a result, a loosening or detachment of the windows cannot be ruled out over the vehicle's lifetime, which could increase the risk of injury in the event of a crash. In addition, loosening of secured objects cannot be ruled out for vehicles with lashing rails, which could increase the risk of injury for vehicle occupants.</p>	
What We're Doing	<p>DVUSA is conducting a voluntary recall. As a precautionary measure, an authorized Freightliner Sprinter dealer will check the adhesion of the topcoat paint on the affected vehicles. Depending on the result of that check, the window area of the affected vehicles will be stripped, and repainted, and the windows will be reinstalled. If the repair is not feasible, DVUSA will offer to repurchase the vehicle from the customer.</p>
