Issue: On vehicles manufactured within a specific period, the pressure and temperature sensors in the air conditioning system may fail. If this happens, the air conditioning system will no longer function.

- Repair:**
- REPAIR AVAILABLE – February 13, 2024 / Inspect and, if necessary, replace the affected pressure & temperature sensors.
 - See ELSA/Service References for complete repair & claiming instructions
 - Check both the daily Campaign Open Inventory report and OMD for affected vehicles in inventory. Verify OPEN status in ELSA on the day of repair.
 - Repair every affected inventory vehicle before delivery to consumers.
