- 3. Pull the fuses for the window regulators while the vehicle is still in accessory mode.

Note: For the driver's side windows pull fuse F50UA and F52UA for the passenger.

- 4. Wait 5 seconds and then re-install both fuses.
- 5. Try to express the window up and see if the window stops.

Note: The window should stop as the learn sequence has not been completed.

- 6. Manually hold the window switch in the up position until the window stops, hold for 2 seconds.
- 7. Verify the functionality.
