

DESCRIPTION

Some customers may complain that the driver side seatback reclining position seems to change by itself. This may be caused unknowingly by the customer when they exit the vehicle. The customer's leg may be contacting the recliner switch and changing the seatback reclining position.

NOTE: This issue does not involve any movement of the seatback while the vehicle is being driven.



The configuration of the recliner switch has been changed to eliminate this concern.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

- 1. Verify the customer concern.
- 2. Replace the recliner switch with a modified new part according to the instructions on MS3 online or the Workshop Manual (section 09-13 FRONT SEAT SIDE COVER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION).
- 3. Verify the repair.
