SUBJECT:

LEATHER STEERING WHEEL CLEANING

Description:

Some vehicles may exhibit dirt or buildup on the leather steering wheel. If any of these conditions are found, do not replace the steering wheel. Instead, follow the cleaning procedure described below.

NOTICE

The steering wheel does not need to be removed to perform the cleaning procedure.



Applicable Vehicles:

- All vehicles equipped with leather steering wheels.

CLEANING PROCEDURE:

1. Spray the leather restorer onto the microfiber cloth.

NOTICE

The steering wheel does not need to be removed to perform the cleaning procedure.



2. Using the microfiber cloth, rub the leather restorer into the steering wheel. Wipe any leftover residue with a clean portion of the cloth.



3. For heavier dirt and buildup, spray a cleaning pad with leather restorer and scrub the steering wheel. Wipe the residue off with a clean microfiber cloth.

**CAUTION**

Do not leave the steering wheel wet or slippery. Wipe any residue off of the steering wheel.
