Safety Requirements for Handling the ARINIX® Hose Tip (Connector, Water Hose)

- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining Personal Protection Equipment (PPE). If no such instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE exist, use detergent and hot water. Keep PPE separate from other laundry.
- Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product.
- Wash the outside of the gloves before removing.

Directions for Use on ALL Repair Procedures

The ARINIX® Tip contains permethrin, a pesticide, as the active ingredient. Please note, it is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Repair Procedure A

- 1. Follow the instructions provided in the Safety Requirements for Handling the ARINIX® Tip (Connector, Water Hose) section of this bulletin.
- 2. Locate the HVAC Evaporator Drain Hose.
- 3. Following the vehicle specific Repair Manual, remove the HVAC Evaporator Drain Hose.
- 4. Put on all necessary PPE and install the ARINIX® Tip (Connector, Water Hose) into the NEW HVAC Evaporator Drain Hose listed in the Parts Information section of this bulletin.
- 5. When installing the ARINIX® Tip, verify it is fully seated in the HVAC Evaporator Drain Hose as shown in Figure 1.
- 6. Following the vehicle specific Repair Manual, install the HVAC Evaporator Drain Hose.

Repair Procedure B

- 1. Follow the instructions provided in the Safety Requirements for Handling the ARINIX[®] Tip (Connector, Water Hose) section of this bulletin.
- 2. Locate the HVAC Evaporator Drain Hose.
- 3. Following the vehicle specific Repair Manual, remove the HVAC Evaporator Drain Hose.
- 4. Put on all necessary PPE and install the ARINIX® Tip into the <u>original</u> HVAC Evaporator Drain Hose listed in the Parts Information section of this bulletin.
- 5. When installing the ARINIX® Tip, verify it is fully seated in the HVAC Evaporator Drain Hose as shown in Figure 1.
- 6. Following the vehicle specific Repair Manual, install the HVAC Evaporator Drain Hose.
