PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Engine Whine Noise At 1500-1800 RPM

Models: 2011-2013 Cadillac Escalade Models 2011-2013 Chevrolet Silverado, Suburban, Tahoe 2011-2013 GMC Sierra, Yukon With any of the following V8 Engine RPO Codes: 5.3L, 6.2L LC9, LMG, LH9, L94, L9H

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

Condition/Concern

You may receive a vehicle with a concern of an audible engine whine noise at 1500-1800 rpm. This noise can be heard inside vehicle at or near the right side of dash/bulkhead area.

Recommendation/Instructions

If this is encountered: follow the steps below.

- 1. Verify the coolant level
- 2. Remove the serpentine belt to verify the noise goes away
- 3. Replace the thermostat and retest
- 4. If replacing the thermostat does not repair the audible engine whine noise at 1500-1800 rpm, replace the water pump
