Issue

Active or intermittent occurrence of Fault Code 3596 (Aftertreatment 1 Diesel Exhaust Fluid Pressure Sensor - Data erratic, intermittent, or incorrect).

It has been determined on 2013 Petebilt[™] Legacy (367, 386, 388, and 389) models that the ground wiring at the DEF pump connector has been incorrectly pinned from the original equipment manufacturer (OEM) factory. Peterbilt[™] has issued a field communication to alleviate this condition. This is an OEM-owned repair. Warranty is to be filed through the appropriate Peterbilt[™] channels.

Verification

See attached OEM documentation for the field fix. Clear faults and follow troubleshooting tree for FC3596 to make sure the fault was cleared.
