Service

- 1. On the affected side(s), remove any corrosion and dirt from the wheel bearing housing and the wheel bearing.




Figure 1. Area to apply paste.

- Using a brush, apply a thin coat of paste (part number G 052109A2) on the wheel bearing housing as shown (Figure 1). Make sure not to apply any paste on the threads.
