Situation: On vehicles fitted with a powered tailgate, water may enter the luggage compartment when the tailgate is opened.

Cause: This may be caused by water being trapped on the anti-pinch strip installation points when the tailgate is in the closed position.

NOTE: right-hand shown; left-hand similar.


Remove the right-hand anti-pinch strip from the tailgate.



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NOTE: repeat this step on both sides of the vehicle. 3.4


Use a suitable tool to measure and mark the areas to be drilled.



4. CAUTION: do not drill through to the visible side of the anti-pinch strip


NOTE: repeat this step on both sides of the vehicle.

Using a suitable tool, drill four 4 mm holes in the areas shown.



5. ONOTE: repeat this step on both sides of the vehicle.

Use a suitable tool to measure and mark the area to be drilled.



6. ONOTE: repeat this step on both sides of the vehicle.


Using a suitable tool, drill a 6 mm hole in the area shown.



7. CAUTION: make sure no damage is caused to the tailgate paintwork.

NOTE: repeat this step on both sides of the vehicle.

Install the right-hand anti-pinch strip to the tailgate.



8. Close the tailgate.
