| Condition | Some vehicles may have a DTC U0155, Lost Communication with Instrument Cluster, stored in the Passenger Presence System (PPS) module. There may or may not be other modules that have stored a U0155 DTC. |

Correction

Important: If U0155 Lost Communication with Instrument Cluster is only set as history and only stored in the PPS module, disregard this DTC for the PPS system.

There is a timing issue between the PPS and IPC when the key is first turned on. The timing issue will correct itself and the DTC will be stored as history. **DO NOT REPLACE ANY MODULE** if PPS is the only module that has set this DTC.

If any other module has set the U0155 Lost Communication with Instrument Cluster, there may be a valid concern with the IPC communication. Follow the proper U-Code diagnostic procedure for the module that reports the U0155.
